GCSE ART EXAM 2017 (Year 11)

All pupils have been given their GCSE Art exam paper this week. Pupils will be working on preparatory work on their chosen exam theme over the following weeks. Pupils should produce as much of their best quality preparatory work (this consists of drawings, research and photography) as they can in class and <u>at home.</u> They can also download the PixIR autodesk App (free on mobiles/tablets/PC!) to edit photos – this scores lots of marks!

The controlled 10 hour final piece will be completed during school time. The exam project contributes to 40% of the final GCSE mark and will be completed by Easter.

Please encourage your child to work hard at home and make use of the extra sessions offered in school: Mon-Fri lunch. Mon, Wed after school (week A and B) and Tues (week B) after school.
