CAT TESTS

All Year 7 pupils will sit their CAT tests on Monday, 11 September. This will take place during P1 & 2. Cognitive Ability Tests (CAT tests) are taken by all Year 7 pupils in all schools across Lancashire. They are not tests that pupils can revise for but they do help us, as a school, by providing more information about a pupil's ability. Pupils should not feel anxious or nervous about the tests. They are taken online and are multiple choice questions.

ADMISSIONS – SEPTEMBER 2018

The process of applying for high school places in September 2018 has now begun for Year 6 pupils. Parents wishing to choose Our Lady's should apply online at http://www.lancashire.gov.uk/children-education-families/schools/apply-for-a-school-place.aspx or via the link on Moodle. Parents should ensure that preferences are selected in the correct order as Lancashire County Council always aim to offer places in order of preference. Please be aware that it is necessary to apply even if a brother or sister is already at Our Lady's and it is imperative that all applications are received **before the deadline of 31 October 2017.** In addition to the Lancashire application process we ask that a Supplementary Form is completed. These forms are available on the school website or from reception.
