## **WINTER PE KIT**

As we are approaching colder climates, please note the following additions have been made to the current PE kit. Pupils can wear the items listed below (following the guidelines) as of next week.

## Girls

- The addition of fitness leggings (currently used in dance/drama)
- These must be worn underneath the current skort
- Skins/compression tops may be worn underneath current PE tops
- These must be plain black with no large brands or logos and reach the ankle (leggings)
- Leggings without the skort will not be permitted
- Girls must continue to wear the current PE socks

## Boys:

- The addition of under armour/compression skins
- These must be worn underneath either the current shorts or OLCHS PE tops
- These must be plain black in colour with no large brands or logos and reach the ankle (bottom half)
- Boys must continue to wear the current PE socks

# Mixed:

Black gloves allowed to be worn depending on activity (not practical for throwing/catching activities)
