E-SCOOTERS

We have received a message from the Lancashire Constabulary Road Safety Partnership regarding E-Scooters. E-Scooters have been in the news over the past months as an eco-friendly method of transport. It is inevitable that some students will receive one of these for a Christmas present. Currently it is illegal to ride an E-Scooter on a public road or pavement in Lancashire. They are classed as a motor vehicle and subject to the same legal requirements such as MOT, Tax, Licensing and Insurance. Please see the leaflet attached with this Newsletter which explains in more detail what the situation is regarding E-Scooters; the fact that they cannot be ridden on the public highway and so should not be ridden to school.
