JJ EFFECT

On Friday, 2 July and Wednesday, 7 July all pupils were given a presentation called 'The JJ effect'. The talk lasted nearly two hours and pupils were given the opportunity to ask questions and talk afterwards about what they had learned. COVID INFORMATION

On Wednesday, 21 July there will be a mobile testing site on St Anthony's car park offering residents a PCR test and encouraging them and reminding them to take regular lateral flow tests. This is particularly important as restrictions will be lifted and families will be mixing more over the summer. Testing is for those WITHOUT symptoms. The testing site will be open from 10.00 am until 4.00 pm.

LOCKERS

All pupils in Years 8, 9 and 10 are required to remove the locks from their existing lockers by Wednesday, 14 July at the very latest. The locks should be taken home and kept safe ready for September when new lockers will be allocated. Any locks which are not removed will be cut off and pupils will need to buy a new lock at the cost of £1.50. If current Year 7 pupils wish to hire a locker from September parents need to pay £16 on Scopay for the 4-year rental.

LOST PROPERTY

Again, we have accumulated a large quantity of lost property, including PE kits, winter coats and shoes. These items have been left unclaimed in the lost property room for a number of weeks. Parents may wish to come and look for missing items, we ask that you telephone reception beforehand and make an appointment. Items will be stored until the end of term and if they are not claimed after this time, they will be sent to local charity shops or for recycling.
