CARDINAL NEWMAN AND PRESTON'S COLLEGE APPLICATIONS 2017

Year 11 pupils should be applying for Newman College and Preston's College now. The deadline for Cardinal Newman College is 10 Feb 2017 but pupils are advised to complete their applications ASAP. All pupils have had an assembly explaining how to apply online so please can you encourage them to get started if they have not already done so.

To apply to Newman College pupils must;

- Register and get a password
- They can apply for up to 6 courses
- They can take up to 4 A levels
- They will be asked to put in their target grades which will be checked at interview.
- Attendance – in Spring they will attend an interview where they will take a copy of their attendance and school report – Newman are looking for 95% or above attendance.
- Personal statement pupils need to write a long paragraph about themselves talking about ;
 - Badges gained, prefecting, societies they belong to and hobbies they are interested in.
 - Why they want to study these courses?
 - Why they want to study at Newman?
- This needs to be a word document, 1 side A4, copy and paste it into the application form.
- Check carefully everything is filled out correctly.
- Once submitted, you can't change anything.
- The process for Prestons' college is very similar to the above.

There are careers drop in sessions every Wednesday lunchtime in the Year 11 common room. Pupils need to speak to their form tutors if they need help with any of the above.

CAREERS

I am in the office on the ground floor of the mathematics block, next to the Year 11 common room.
