Congratulations to the year 7B Football team who took part in the Preston Schools' Football final which took place on Monday, 12 December at Ashton High School. The team had three games to play against Archbishop Temple, Corpus Christi and Ashton High School. The four teams formed a mini league, playing 10 minute games without any rests. The winner was the team with the most points at the end of the night. The boys started off strongly beating Ashton 3-0 in the first game which saw a fantastic headed goal by James Woods and an equally impressive finish from front man, Can Doguer. In the second game against Archbishop Temple the teams were evenly matched but Our Lady's took too many risks in their own half which proved costly. The game finished 2-0 to Archbishop. In the final game against Corpus Christi Our Lady's created some great chances but we couldn't find an end product - we took an extra touch or played an extra pass and gave possession away too easily. The team was pressing for a goal and Corpus countered with pace accuracy. They created some great chances which brought the best out of Our Lady's goalkeeper Josh Lucas who made some great saves all night. The final game finished 3-0 to Corpus Christi.
