



The Programme

Step 1: Dealership Open Evening (Jan/Feb)

You and your parent or guardian will attend an evening event at a Vantage dealership. You'll hear presentations from Vantage Directors and other senior personnel providing further details about the programme. Plus, you'll get a tour of the dealership and get involved in what we call a 'career speed networking' event, during which you can ask Vantage staff questions about their jobs to get a flavour of what it's all about and some further insight into working in the automotive industry.

Whilst you're having some fun, your parent or guardian can take the opportunity to chat and ask questions about the programme with the Vantage HR team.

Toward the end of the evening, over refreshments, you too can chat to one of our personnel. If you would like to proceed with t me you will let us know at the end of the evening.



All applicants will attend a half day employability skills training and selection day at the dealership. This will help prepare you by giving you skills and a mock interview prior to being interviewed for your apprentice position at Vantage by one of our personnel. All attendees will receive a certificate of attendance. The business will then determine which candidates will move on to the next stage of the programme.

Step 3: Work Experience Week (July-August)

If you are successful, you'll undertake a one week work experience programme at the dealership. All attendees will receive a certificate of attendance, and a reference from Vantage personnel.

Step 4: Job Offers (August)

If successful you will then be offered a Vehicle Technician Apprenticeship at the site.

Step 5: Employment Starts (September)

As a successful candidate your new career will begin!
