## GCSE English Literature theatre educational visit to see 'An Inspector Calls' at the Liverpool Empire Theatre, Liverpool Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023

The English Department are organising an educational visit to watch a performance of 'An Inspector Calls' at the Liverpool Empire Theatre in Liverpool which will take place next academic year. Our current Year 9 and 10 pupils study this play as one of their set texts for their English Literature exams. We believe that it would be beneficial and worthwhile for them to see Stephen Daldry's epic production. Our current Year 10 have studied the play and this production will be a wonderful way to revise the text. For our current Year 9 pupils it will provide an immersive experience of live theatre and provide a greater understanding of Priestley's work in preparation for their study of the play for GCSE English Literature the following term.

The educational visit will take place on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023. We will leave school at 17.00 and will be returning at approximately 23.15. Pupils will need to be collected from school upon their return.

There are 150 tickets available to purchase for the performance, if interest exceeds the number of tickets then we will select names randomly to ensure fairness. The cost will be £25.00, which includes return coach travel and the theatre ticket. To ensure that you secure a ticket you should make your payment via our online payment system:

However, we must secure payment now to book the tickets that have been reserved for our pupils. Please ensure that payment is made by the deadline. Please note that this visit is covered by Lancashire County Council public liability insurance but there is no personal accident insurance cover provided for your child. If you feel that this is necessary, you will need to make separate arrangements.
