Rewards

Each pupil will begin each half term with 10 points and will be rewarded by keeping them through gaining entry in our end of half term rewards assemblies.

Rewards are also given when staff spot pupils being one of ours.

Keeping Points

Classroom and form teachers can remove a point from a pupil for the following:

- **arriving late to class**
- **being without the correct book(s), kit or equipment**
- **arriving to class wearing uniform incorrectly**

Commitment to School Life

Pupils can earn points for showing commitment to the School in the following areas.

- Representing school
- Charity work/fundraising
- Service to school
- Supporting the school environment
- Contribution to the Spiritual life of the school

These points will be added to B4L points and counted towards totals for the earning of star badges. A new badge will be awarded when a pupil meets the threshold on the criteria

Classroom Code Of Conduct

Classroom Management

The key here is to find ways to help pupils see the danger signs and modify their behaviour to avoid being referred.

The focus is on the Classroom Code of Conduct

There are 4 stages

1. Remind the pupil of the rule
2. Issue a formal warning
3. Pupil moved within the classroom
4. Refer the pupil to another teacher

How Referrals Will Work

- The pupil will be sent to another teacher in the subject area
- Any pupil referred receives a 30 minute after school Detention the following evening and his/her parents are contacted through synergy/phone call
- A pupil must have a conversation with the member of staff before the return to the next lesson.
