Blackpool Pleasure Beach

Preparation before we go

- All pupils attending must provide a mobile phone number which the pupil can be contacted on.
- All pupils attending must stay in a group- min of 3 per group. Pupils must give the names of the people in their group on the group sheet.
- BPB operate a cashless system. You can use debt card or apply pay. You can also use a free 'BPB' card which we can issue you on the day.
- If using the BPB card, **do not put all your money** on the card as the funds are non-refundable. There is top-up points around the park. The card is valid for two years
- Burger king accept debit card or cash. They do not accept the BPB card.
- You can bring your own food/lunch

Medication

- Should you need medication, such as epi pen or inhaler, you keep it with you during the day
- Should you have prescribed medication you take at a specific time, see your Learning Manager before you go.
- If in doubt ask your Learning Manager

On the morning of the trip

BLACKPOOL PUPILS

- All pupils must be in school on time and register in their form rooms
- Form tutors take the register and then wait for the tannoy which will tell staff and pupils which form groups should make their way to the coaches
- Form tutor to escort pupils to the buses
- Staff will direct you as to which coach you should get on.
- Registers will be taken again before you get on the bus

Morning of the trip

STAYING IN SCHOOL

- Pupils who are not attending (remaining in school) must attend school in full school uniform.
- Year 8, Year 9 and Year 10 pupils not attending are to bring their PE kit with them.
- Pupils will go to form to be registered. When your form has been called to the coaches, you will be directed to go to the sports hall.

On the bus

- Mobile phone **are not** to be used on the bus
- We do not consume any food or drink
- We keep our seat belts fastened for the full journey
- We are prophetic in demonstrating outstanding behaviour
- We stay in the same seat going to and from Blackpool
- We let the staff coach lead know if a pupil is missing
- You will be given a card with the school mobile number. Add the number to your contacts or keep the card safe.

On the bus- wrist bands

HOW TO FIT A WRISTBAND

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS...

It is very important that the wristband is fitted onto the **RIGHT** wrist. Our scanners for the rides are on the right hand side and if a wristband is fitted onto the left wrist, that person will be unable to access the ride. It is recommended that a Leader puts on the wristband on the child's wrist.

1 On the reverse of the wristband, you will see an area that says "Peel Away This Area"; holding onto the backing, peel back the coloured sticky area.



2 Once you have pulled back the coloured area enough, the backing paper will detach from the wristband leaving a sticky tab.



3 Holding the sticky tab in your right hand and the flat end of the wristband in your left hand, slide the wristband underneath the person's **RIGHT** arm.



4 With your left hand, bring the wristband over the person's arm and hold it down on their wrist.



5 Then use your right hand to wrap the wristband around their wrist and press the sticky tab down to hold the wristband in place.



6 You must ensure there is sufficient room between the wristband and wrist for it to move comfortably. It should not be so loose that it is possible to slide the wristband off the wrist.



When we are there

- The staff will be based in the staff area, near the dancing water fountains



When we are there

- Pupils stay inside the park
- Pupils are allowed to use their phone in the park
- All pupils are expected to display outstanding behaviour and conduct
- Pupils walk around in their groups- **do not leave** anyone by themselves
- Unless a single seated ride, pupils should not go on rides alone
- Ensure you stay hydrated and make time to have your lunch
- Be careful when leaving belongings whilst you are on a ride- do not forget to pick them up at the end!

Keeping yourself safe

- Should you be worried about an interaction with an unknown individual, go to a safe place, tell a member of Blackpool staff and call the school mobile number.
- If you get separated from your group you must call the school mobile number to let staff know or come to the staff meeting area.
- Should any member of your group be injured, you must call the school mobile number.
- Do not accept gifts from anyone you do not know.
- Keep all valuables out of sight- thieves operate in the area and pick pockets are very skilled
- Be vigilant- We must watch out for one another.

Check in

- **You must check in** with staff, at the staff area near the dancing water fountains, between 12:00 and 13:00
- A register will be taken when you check in
- Be sure to say 'Hello' to the members of staff walking round when you see them!

End of the day

- Pupils will meet by 'water fountains', near staff area at 3:15pm. Pupils ***MUST*** be on time.
- You will line up in forms
- You will be escorted to your coach
- Ensure you sit in the same seat. Let staff know if anyone is missing
- *On our return to school, should there be any delay, coach leads will give permission to contact parents*

Dress Code for Rewards Trip



- No Bellies, Bottoms, or revealing clothing
- No rude slogans or images
- No thin straps on tops
- No heels, crocs, sliders or flip flops



- Hats and sun cream should be worn (if hot)
- Comfortable trainers or pumps should be worn
- Dress appropriately for the weather
- Clothing with zips to store valuables securely

Dress Code for Blackpool



- No hot pants
- No short skirts
- Normal school rules regarding makeup, fake tan and jewellery will apply

- Mid thigh shorts or skirts are acceptable
- Leggings can be worn but must be worn with a long t-shirt (no underwear to be seen)
- Jeans with rips on the knee only are acceptable. Rips elsewhere are not!
