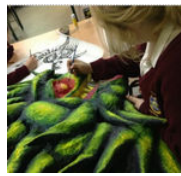

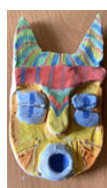

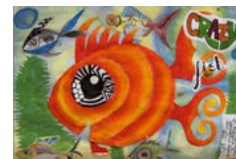

Practising drawing, colour and design skills looking at the work of Vincent Scarpace.



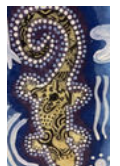
Great Barrier Reef: gathering knowledge and sources to develop ideas.
